






Linda Eyerman Katerina's Second Chance

Banks Home magazine, among other publications.










Dr. Charles E. Herdendorf




Susan Poole Out of the Crash



Develop the practice of listening to your writing voice.

The art of writing is a practice. Writer and publishing expert Brandi Larsen will share the Story Workshop Method, a way to generate creative writing that focuses on a joyful and playful way to take to the page.
